
#### **Fusion Easter Service**

## Fearfully and Wonderfully Made

Psalms 139: 1-18

One of my devotions this week was from Psalms 139. Verse 13 says that God has knitted us together in our mother's womb, and verse 14 says that we were fearfully and wonderfully made.

How often do we think that we are who we are because God loved us so much that he knitted us together in our mother's womb. He made us. Genesis 2:7 says that God made man from the dust of the earth and breathed the breath of life into him. Wow! Just stop and think about that for a moment. Then she heard a voice in her head that said, "She was fearfully and wonderfully made". Immediately, she was humbled and sorry for thinking badly of the woman, because she knew that what she heard was true. Then she heard "Pray for her".

How often are we frustrated by the circumstances in life? Something happens that isn't anyone's fault, yet, we become frustrated and perhaps even angry.

I wonder what would happen if we stopped right at that moment and said a prayer for the person our frustration was aimed at or the circumstance that upset us?

Each of us was fearfully and wonderfully made by God and He loves us all equally. His Spirit is in each of us. We just need to recognize that and thank Him who made us and call on that Spirit to lead us in each circumstance every day. He has promised to be with us always.

We are blessed to be a blessing.
