
Bible Studies are back in person


The Monday night study will be led by Jan Badgett and meet the 1st and 3rd Mondays every month.

What Do You Believe?

Many are leaving the Christian church today because they don't know what to believe. Young people today are being taught in our schools about evolution, not creation. They are led to believe that we are evolved creatures, no created by God and that most likely, man created God in his mind. I find this hard to believe, but it is being professed in every medium in every part of the earth. Advertising today says that it's already to break the rules (sin) as long as it satisfies your needs or you don't get caught. Is that what we followers o Jesus Christ believe?

As our affirmation of faith says, "I believe in God, the Father Almighty, maker (or creator) of heaven and earth, and in Jesus Christ his only Son, our Lord, and Savior, who was created by God as a man to live among us and teach us a more perfect way to live and to die on the cross to save us from our sins. On the third day, He was raised from the dead by God as Jesus said he would be and lives today in Heaven with His Father and our Father, God." Do you believe this and tell others?

Genesis 1:26-27 says that God made or created man in His own image and breathed the breath of life into him. His breath (spirit) lives within each of us. 

Christians are called to show love to our enemies as found in 1 Chorinthians 13:4-7, 13. We are called to follow the example of Jesus. God is our light in the darkness


