JUNIOR HIGH AND HIGH SCHOOL Saturday, April 1, and Sunday, April 2 Young Christians Weekend at Silver Dollar City



FINANCIAL BRIEF By: Ben Stone

Year-to-date financial summary through January 31, 2023:

Revenue \$88,821 Budgeted Expenses \$117,815 Actual Expenses \$91,057 Net \$(2,236)

The original amount of the loan for the new Learning Center was \$4,162,200. The current balance as of January 31, 2023, is \$3,359,155.

Aldersgate's 2023 is off to a good start, with giving up significantly from January 2022. While we are starting off with a deficit, it is a much smaller deficit than at this time last year. Further, worship attendance is up, and Sunday School classes are growing.

We recently experienced a wonderful Ash Wednesday service led by our current Confirmation class. It was an enjoyable and meaningful service, and I wondered how many future pastors, worship leaders, lay leaders, etc. are in that group of confirmands.

To help them, as well as our other children and youth, continue to grow on their spiritual path, our church leaders are calling for us to consider adding gifts of service during Lent. If you also give up chocolate, consider throwing your candy money into the offering box! Whether service, financial, or other gifts, thank you for all you bring to Aldersgate.
