

Sound Booth



Grace

Romans 3: 21-24 – "For all have sinned and fallen short of the glory of God and are justified freely by His grace as a gift, through the redemption that came by Jesus Christ."

Psalm 145: 8-9 – "The Lord is gracious and compassionate, slow to anger and rich in love. The Lord is good to all; he has compassion on all he has made."

Titus 2: 11 – "'For the grace of God has appeared that offers salvation to all people."

Jesus Christ was offered as a sacrifice for all creation to save us from our sin, now and forever. If we will only recognize that sin and confess it before God and ask for His forgiveness, He will forgive us and hold us blameless. We just need to believe that Jesus Christ is the Son of God, knowing that our belief in Him will save us from all unrighteousness.

You're busy. I'm busy. Your calendar, like mine, is crammed with commitments from work, family, school, friends and community activities. And somewhere, if you find a free space, a little R & R sounds like heaven.

Our church calendar is even more busy! Our Aldersgate family continues to grow as we continue in our commitment to reach out with the love of Christ and teach the Word to make disciples with an active faith in Jesus Christ for the transformation of the world. Praise God for the work of his Holy Spirit!

With over 500 people worshipping here together across multiple services each Sunday, our church family has reached a size where it is difficult to know everyone, and that makes it easy to get detached from the heartbeat of the church. As a result, we are struggling to staff vital ministries with unpaid servants.



I know we have many teens and adults who really love kids and want them to know how much Jesus loves them. Our superb turnout of VBS helpers each year is proof! But we are always so short of teachers and helpers for children's Sunday school and Wednesday Night Kids that it becomes a crisis whenever a teacher has to call in sick.

I know we have many adults who love teens and know how important it is to connect them to God the Rock in the storms of adolescence who would make great youth sponsors! (Even helping provide snacks on a regular basis would be a huge help!)

I know we have many adults who recognize the need for church security and who have a protector's heart of service required for such a role. But we still don't have enough members of SHIELD to provide security for all activities where kids and youth are present, let alone all our other activities.

I know we have plenty of good writers and photographers who would make great Gatepost reporters, plenty of smiling faces who would make great greeters and ushers, plenty of singers and musicians who would make great additions to our choir and praise teams, and plenty of growing disciples who would make great small group leaders or class facilitators. We have no lack of spiritual gifts among us and no one who lacks a spiritual gift because the apostle Paul affirms in 1 Corinthians 12:7, "Now to each one the manifestation of the Spirit is given for the common good."



This is an encouragement, not a guilt trip. Take the time to discover your spiritual gifts and how you can use them "for the common good." Just like other abilities, spiritual gifts can get rusty with disuse. No one can do everything. But growing as a disciple of Jesus Christ means everyone should be serving somewhere and somehow.

Now What?

Almost half of the congregation has attended one of the Town Hall meetings this summer, which is impressive! - empowerment to discover ways to minister to our community where they are,
- learn, live and share scriptural truths not adapted to cultural beliefs
- grow in holy living, both individually and as a congregation, and
- experience the excitement to serve Christ, the one who loves us the most.

so we can be Christ in the world.

- through the denominational connection, reclaim the church's evangelistic DNA for the whole world to know of God's gift of grace,
- seek and trust the Holy Spirit to guide us to be compassionate, and obedient in guiding others toward Christ
- open us up to new ideas for reaching the unchurch
- more importantly, through the testimony of new connections we receive encouragement to listen for God's voice, trust His leading, and share His love in simple, powerful ways,

Soon, we will have the wonderful opportunity to potentially affirm the recommendation to join the Global Methodist Church going forward. Ask questions, pray for God's will to be done and to grow as a church to remain true to who we are and to follow God's plan for making disciples for Jesus Christ here and throughout the world.

Leading up to our congregational vote on September 7, we encourage you to continue exploring what it means to be a Methodist. If you have not yet become a member of Aldersgate, it just might be the right time to speak to Pastor Dennis or Sarah to talk about it, as only members are eligible to vote on official church decisions such as this.
